The year has started quite busy with auditions having just been completed and the cast announced for **NOISES OFF**. I am aware that the cast announcement was somewhat delayed and our apologies for this. This was due to the Director and Assistant Director having to make very difficult decisions with regards to casting due to the very high calibre of auditionees. It is very pleasing to see actors who have performed with us previously returning to the theatre and we welcome those who will be performing on the Off Broadway stage for the first time.

As Barb will mention later in the newsletter, we have the **REVIVAL** cabaret show currently rehearsing and they are sounding absolutely amazing. This time there will also be a live 5-piece band accompanying the singers. Please do come and support your local theatre as the singers are very kindly doing this as a fundraiser for PTC, as we like other amateur theatre companies have struggled through covid-19 with lost hires and reduced seating capacity. I wish to thank the singers and musicians for kindly giving their time.

This will be held on Saturday 25 March at Central Park, Papakura and is a free picnic style concert. It will feature some local community bands, singers and cultural groups. I will also be inviting anyone wishing to sing as part of a choir which will perform with the bands at the end of the programme. Also, due to Council budget constraints this may be the last PSVC for quite some time.

As you will all know, Auckland has been through some devastating weather over the last couple of weeks. I was on duty on the Friday night when Auckland suffered the worst of the weather. At one point we had over 1650 pending incidents that required our attendance. I hope that you were all okay and my thoughts go out to all those affected in one way or another.

On behalf of the PTC committee, I would like to take this opportunity to thank one of our committee members, Cheryl Simpson. As you would have read in the previous newsletter, Cheryl has undertaken an immense amount of work for Musical Theatre New Zealand (MTNZ) on behalf of all the members including PTC. Her countless hours spent liaising with other theatres and MTNZ, and utilising her expert knowledge of trusts has ensured that her rewriting of the deed passed a unanimous vote first time at a recent special general meeting, having been rejected at several meetings prior.




