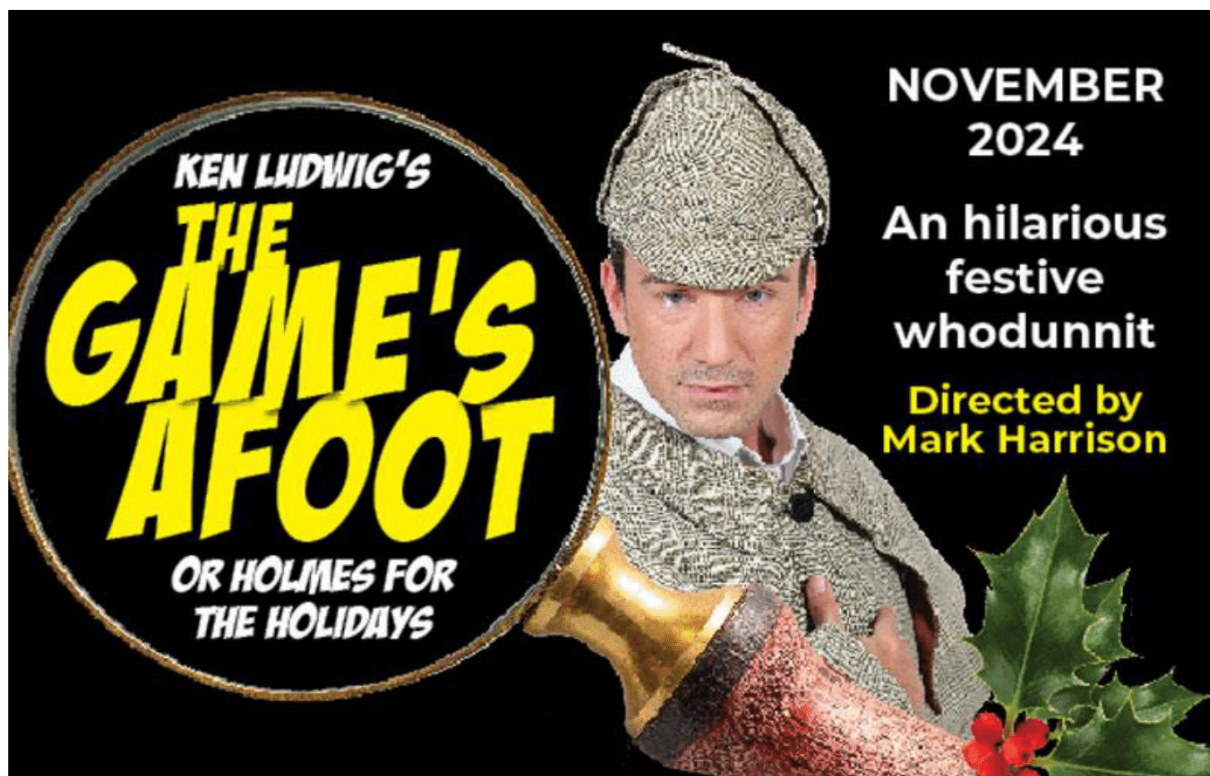

MUSICAL THEATRE NZ (MTNZ) AGM & TRAINING WEEKEND (otherwise known as 'Conference')

Last weekend (15-17 March) seven PTC members travelled to Rotorua to attend this event. They attended various seminars including Office Bearers' Fundamentals (the roles of President, Secretary, Treasurer etc), Job Descriptions, Making the Most of Mentoring, Broadway Ambitions v Amateur Budget plus a forum with Copyright Holders.

At the MTNZ AGM the election of officers took place, with Emma Bishop now taking on the role of President of MTNZ. PTC congratulates Emma and wishes her every success with this new responsibility. Emma lives and breathes theatre and has enormous drive and vision so it will be interesting to see where she takes MTNZ over the next couple of years.

One of the important discussions which took place was with the Trustees of the new Musical Theatre Foundation of Aotearoa, which our committee member Cheryl Simpson, as chairperson, addressed. Cheryl was elected Chair of the Trust which is taking the place of the old Capital Assistance Fund. PTC has contributed to this fund since its inception by contributing 5 cents for every seat sold for every show. It allows participating societies to borrow money interest free to purchase capital assets such as new lights, sound equipment and indeed many years ago is how PTC was able to purchase the tiered seating. This was paid off over a period of seven years at no interest. Recently we borrowed again so that we could purchase some new lighting equipment. It is a really beneficial arrangement.
