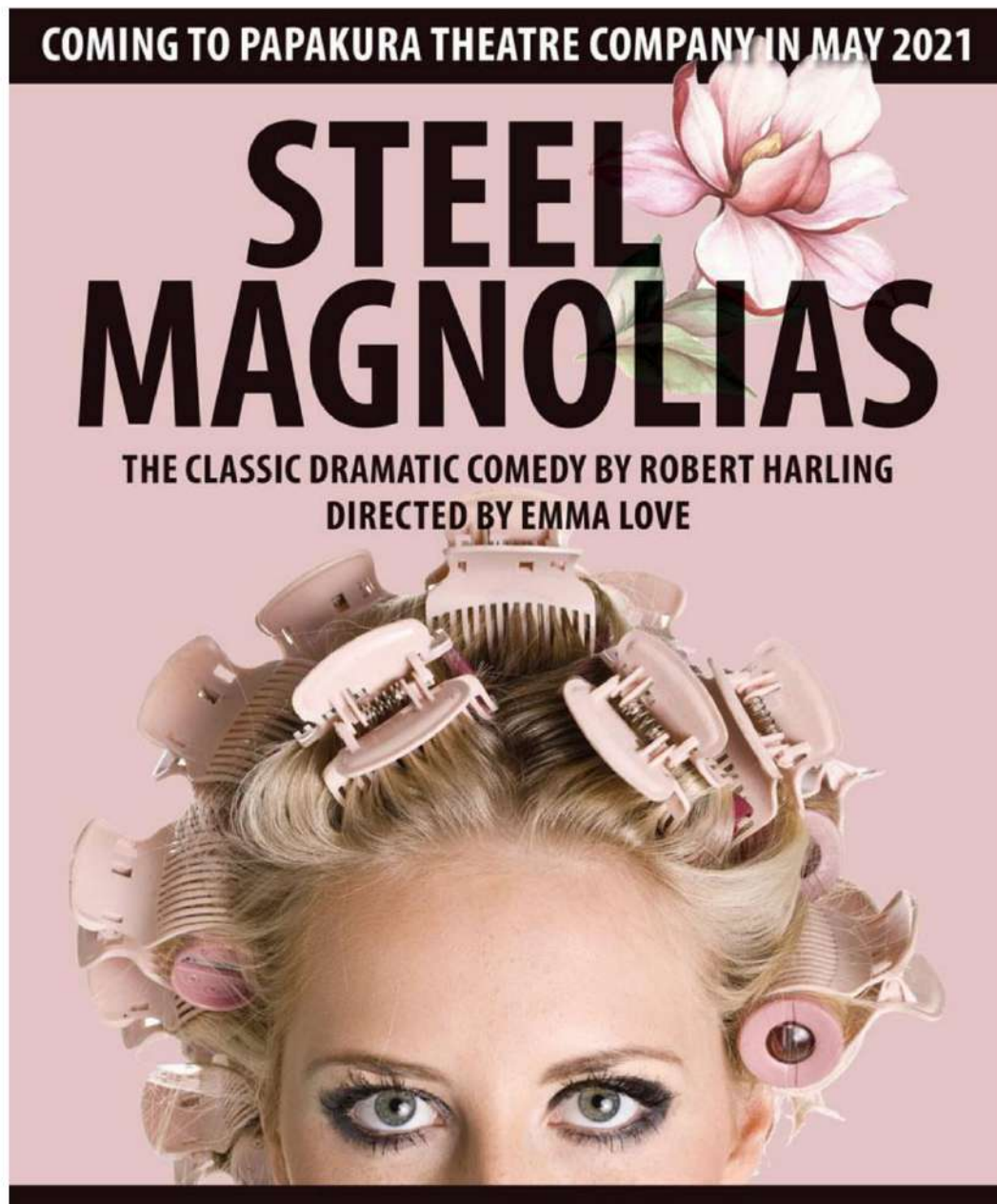
There will be the usual pizza and chips for dinner BUT this time it's PTC's treat.




## THE DARK CIRCUS – Off Broadway on 30<sup>th</sup> October
