Papakura Theatre Company is incredibly saddened to let our members and friends know that Patty Reid passed away on the afternoon of Thursday 4th November at the Pukekohe Rehab Hospital with husband Noel at her side. Patty was admitted to Middlemore Hospital in early August with a deep-seated lung infection and heart problem. She was in Middlemore until she was transferred to the Pukekohe Rehab Hospital in late October. With the COVID-19 restrictions currently in place in Auckland, she was unable to have visitors except for Noel. This was devastating for her friends who wanted to visit and support Patty.

Patty joined Papakura Theatre Company in 1979 and ever since then she has been involved in all aspects of our Club's life. Patty served as a committee member, then as President in 1991 and 1992 and again in 1998 and 1999. She became Treasurer from 1981 to 1990 and again from 1995 to 1998. She also took on the responsibility of Bar Manager in those first years that we had a bar at Off Broadway. For her outstanding service to PTC Patty was awarded Life Membership in 1994.

Patty had so many talents and as a costume designer and maker she was superb – her Music Hall costumes were beautiful and in 2015 when she discovered we were unable to hire suitable German uniforms for our production of 'Allo 'Allo, she set to and turned our Green Room into a sewing studio, designed and cut out the uniforms and with help from our Judys and Anne Doddrell, created the required uniforms and won the NAPTA Award for Best Costume Design. In 1995 Patty made her directing debut with Annie. Then came Chess the Musical and her talents as a Director were confirmed. More plays and musicals have followed since.

Patty is the main reason we have Off Broadway Theatre. In 1991 with the likely loss of our old Clubrooms at Ardmore, PTC was starting to seek a new home. In early 1992 Patty looked at what was the old Choice Market building and had the vision to see what it could become and put in an offer on behalf of the Club and thus we have our Theatre – our home. She even won the competition to name the building when she put forward Noel's suggestion of "Off Broadway".

But above all, Patty loved to sing and perform. She was a true entertainer and put her heart and soul into anything she did on and off the stage. She appeared in many musicals and plays over the years. After a spell of approximately 5 years in Rotorua as moteliers, she and Noel moved back to Auckland 8 years ago. They settled in Pukekohe where Patty became involved in a group singing around the local rest homes and on Monday afternoons entertaining the "oldies" at Harrington Hall. She joined the Franklin Choir and very much enjoyed singing with them and also joined the Red Hats ladies' group and the Zimmers' Dance Troup. Patty couldn't wait to get back to her beloved theatre and she became fully involved with PTC once again. Four years ago Lorna invited Patty and I to join her Longford Park Village Choir. We had so much fun with this light-hearted group; we both loved our Thursday afternoons at Longford and our choir concerts singing with them.

In March 2016 Patty was presented with a long-overdue and much deserved Merit Award at Musical Theatre NZ Conference in Rotorua and I was honoured to write up her nomination for the Award. The above photo is of Patty receiving that Award and we both had tears in our eyes – it obviously meant a lot to Patty!

Patty was great company and a respected friend to many in the theatre. She had an infectious laugh, a quick wit and a bubbly personality to match. Patty loved life and everything in it and it loved her right back.

Over 40 years or more Patty played a huge part in the life of PTC in so many ways and she will be very much missed.

Our thoughts, love and prayers are with Noel and family, and all those who have had the privilege of knowing Patty and will have been devastated by this tragic loss.

Patty, you were truly a wonderful friend and I will miss you dearly. You were one in a million – a real star!
